- Backup your data. Protect important files, photos and other things on your devices by backing them up to a separate, secure location. The 3-2-1 rule says: keep three copies of your data, save them on two different types of media, and store one copy in a separate location.
- Securely dispose of old computers, phones and tablets. Before you do, ensure that all personal data has been securely wiped by doing a factory reset. You can use this information from <u>the Wisconsin</u>
  <u>Department of Natural Resources</u> website to find a recycler nearby.
